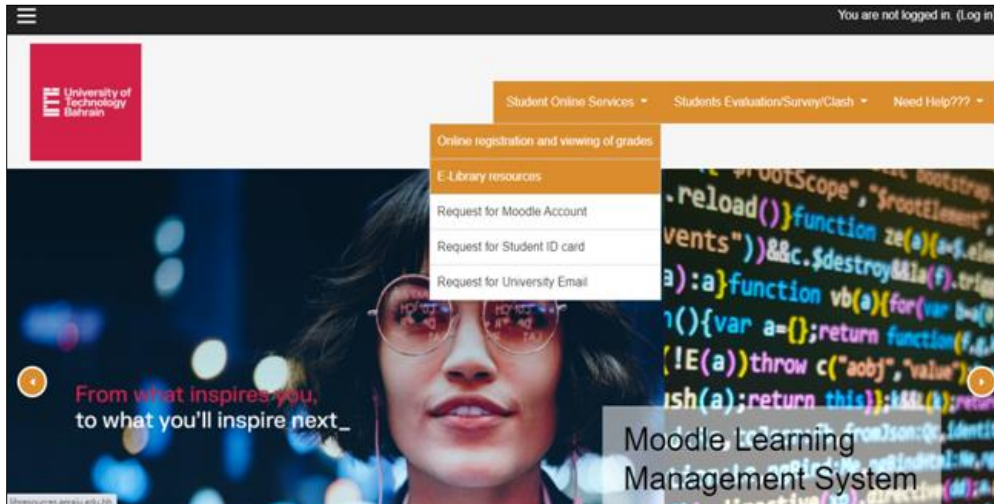


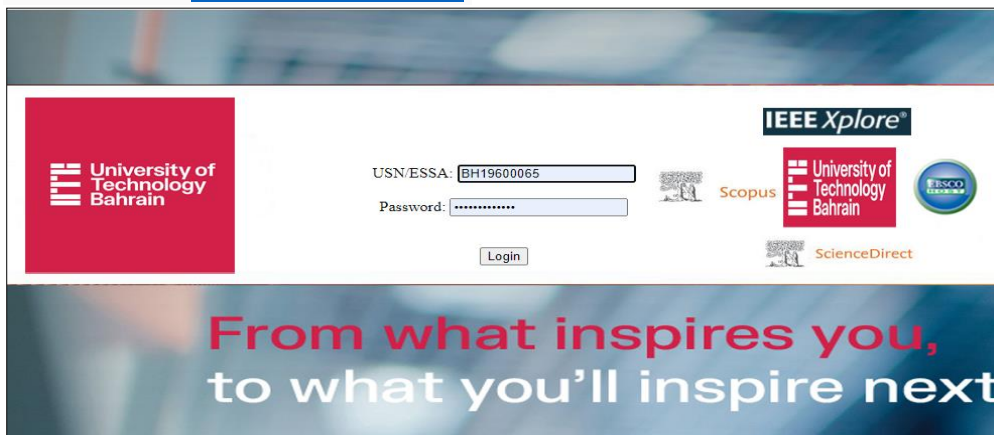
Library Guide - Accessing EBSCO eBook Collection

Click Student Online Services.

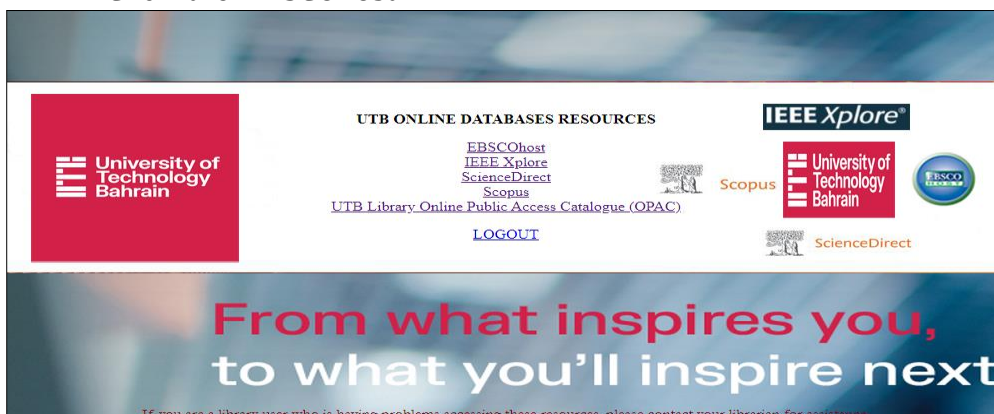


Step 2: Click E- Library resources.


